What does it mean to integrate faith, life and culture?

This four day program (one day in the school) will explore the theological normative of the Enhancing Catholic School Identity (ECSI) project through engagement with the Melbourne, Victoria and Post Critical Belief Scales. Participants will engage in dialogue to gain a deeper understanding of the ECSI data and what it means to be a Catholic School today and into the future. School teams will identify a specific and locally relevant critical challenge arising from the opportunities as revealed by the data. Through the school visit, leaders will be supported as they devise and enact this project.

Please note: This program takes participants beyond the foundational work undertaken in either of the pre-requisite programs 'Re-visiting your ECSI Report' or 'Reading and Interpreting Your New ECSI Report'.
