Getting There

Parking at the Melbourne Zoo located in Elliott Avenue, Parkville (Melways ref 43 E1) is within easy walking distance of the Treacy Centre. Street parking in The Avenue is also available.

Trains run from Flinders Street Station on the Upfield Line and stop at Royal Park Station (near Melbourne Zoo).

Tram 19 from Elizabeth Street stops in Walker Street (Stop 16), and is a 1 minute walk from the Treacy Centre.

How can we learn alongside other schools in order to implement the renewed RE curriculum framework?

The Religious Education Curriculum Framework has been renewed and is currently available to schools in draft form. In seeking to understand and enact this document, schools have an opportunity to work collectively and explore their practice in Religious Education in ways which connect with the ideals of Horizons of Hope, and act on the recommendations of the Enhancing Catholic School Identity Project (ECSIP).

Orientation Day: This half day program is designed for members of leadership teams, particularly principals. **This PL is a repeat of the Orientation Day held on February 15, 2017.** Teams will have the opportunity to develop greater clarity around the focus of their involvement in the Regional Collective, to explore how it connects with their School Improvement and Annual Action Plans and to understand the required commitment throughout the school year. Attendance at **one** Orientation day (February 15 or March 8) is a prerequisite to participation in a Regional Collective.

Regional Collective Days: These four full days will be offered in the four regions of the Archdiocese and are designed for small teams from schools. It is important that members of leadership teams (particularly Religious Education Leaders and Learning & Teaching Leaders) attend. Involvement of at least one classroom teacher is also recommended for these days. Participants will work collaboratively to explore the RE Curriculum Framework and develop strategies for implementation in their school context.
